Campground Guidelines

• CAMPSITE AVAILABILITY IS LIMITED. APPLICATIONS WILL BE PROCESSED IN THE ORDER OF RECEIPT. PRIORITY WILL FIRST BE GIVEN TO NON-LOCAL APPLICANTS; LOCAL APPLICANTS WILL THEN BE ACCEPTED AS SPACE ALLOWS. MERCHANTS WITH PERMANENT STRUCTURES OR WITH SPECIFIC PERMISSION FROM THE CAMPING COORDINATOR FOR TEMPORARY STRUCTURES MAY CAMP AT THEIR MERCHANT LOCATION. PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT THE CAMPING DEPOSIT IS IN ADDITION TO YOUR REGULAR MERCHANT FEES PAID TO THE MERCHANT COMMITTEE.

• PLEASE REMEMBER: A separate registration form AND deposit check will be required for EACH CAMPING SPACE/TENT. Your deposit will be sent to you within thirty (30) days of your departure, providing your campsite is left clean. Ordinary wear will, of course, be allowed.

Please read the following rules and sign below to indicate your acceptance to abide by said rules. Failure to comply may result in expulsion from the campsite. For any Volunteers this may also mean expulsion from all Faire activities.

1. All campers under the age of 16 MUST BE ACCOMPANIED by a parent or guardian.
2. Quiet Hours will be enforced at 11:00pm. Quiet Hours does not equal silence, but it does mean reasonably low conversational tones.
3. Keep your area clean of trash; your site will be inspected before your deposit is returned.
4. No weapons or firearms may be carried in the camp area, with the exception of merchants putting away their wares for the evening and properly peace-bound items.
5. Please do not wander in and out of the campsite during the faire day. We do not want to draw the patrons' attention to the campsite.
6. Only registered campers are allowed in the campsite. Guests MUST notify the camp coordinator for visits. Failure to do so may result in eviction from the campsite. We want our site to be as secure as possible for the safety of ourselves and our possessions.
7. Your location will be assigned to you by the camp coordinator. If you set up in a location not assigned to you, you may be asked to move.
8. No hookups will be provided. Porta Potties will be available. One Camp shower will be available.
9. Pets must be leashed and supervised AT ALL TIMES!

10. No personal campfires will be allowed. One communal fire pit will be provided (Parks Regulations). Small propane cook stoves are allowed.
11. You must obey all rules and regulations imposed by Parks regarding the communal bonfire.
12. Plastics and other trash are **not** to be thrown into the campfire. (i.e. bottles and food wrappers)
13. Campers are **not** allowed to use the electrical boxes located on site except by special permission from the Camp Coordinator.
14. Unregistered Campers will be asked to leave immediately.
15. The camp shower is to be kept clean. This shower is being provided as a courtesy by GSLRF. If the privilege is abused, the shower will be removed.
16. Application must be received no later than two (2) weeks prior to opening day. No on-site applications will be accepted.
17. Underage drinking and/or illegal drug use will not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from site.
